# Message from the Guild co-Chairs

Hello and welcome to the cooler weather of fall. Here's where we left off in May. We approved an upgrade to our website and agreed to be the featured artist at the Jekyll Island Art Association (JIAA) in November 2024. This show is in addition to our previously scheduled GIFG show at the SoGlo Gallery in February 2024.

Our website project representatives, Wanda Ruger and Nancy Harper, have met with website developer Ada Owens. The new page has been designed so that there will be a public information area and a Members Only area. Membership forms will be downloadable and open to accept online data input as well. Eventually we're looking to accept online payments for dues. Presently we have two sites: new and old. However, as they both have the same domain name, only one can be viewed at a time. We opted to keep the old site operational until the new site is fully functional and then the old will be retired. The committee is meeting again in October and we will continue to share updates with you.

It's an honor that we have been invited to participate in the JIAA show. Things to remember about that show is that every item entered must be for sale, 25% commission, each artist must be a member of JIAA, and the JIAA does all the work. Lainie Addessi is the contact.

The GIFG Show in February 2024 is a mix of sale and non-sale items that have not been in a previous GIFG show. The commission is 35%, GIFG members are responsible for putting up and taking down the show. We also ask members to be onsite during the show. We've presented a fashion show on opening night and have an opportunity to do another if there's interest. Louise Eaton is the contact.

In the coming year, we plan to feature each of the creative groups in our newsletter. And we're looking forward to hosting more workshops. In the past two years, members have led workshops in ice dying, beaded decorative spheres, embroidered ornaments and chenille pillows. Please share your ideas with the Program Chairs, Group Chairs or the Co-Chairs and we'll try to accommodate.

Lastly, we encourage you to get as involved as you want to be. Try out and join new-to-you groups. If you're new to the Guild, it's a great way to meet some pretty nice people. Guild members share some fantastic ideas and projects across creative disciplines and levels of expertise and are genuinely welcoming.

# Minutes from Monday, May 02, 2022 GIFG Meeting

- Prior to the meeting being called to order, a representative of the "Golden Isles Liberty Belles" made a presentation about the work the group does in making and presenting quilts to area military veterans.
- General Meeting of The Golden Isles Fiberarts Guild was convened at 3:00 pm on May 2, 2022 at the Holy Nativity Church.

The minutes of the April meeting as they appeared in the newsletter were approved.

Visitors were welcomed: Gabby Fox, Lucia Smeal and Jackie O'Neal.

Joyce Poole, Treasurer, reported a balance of \$1,545.38.

- Lainie Addessi gave a report to the membership on negotiations with the Jekyll Island Art Association's request that GIFA Guild participate in a show in either 2024 or 2025. She outlined the requirements set down by the JIAA as follows:
- 1. Participants would be required to join JIAA for accounting purposes
- 2. All art submitted would be for sale
- 3, Inventory would be submitted 15 days before the show
- 4. A commission of 25% would be assessed

She further stated that all publicity and attending expenses would be incurred by the JIAA.

A motion was made seconded and passed allowing Lainie to proceed with negations with JIAA.

- Nancy Harper and Wanda Ruger reported on meeting with Ada Owens about addressing problems with the website domain. A motion was made, seconded and approved allowing Nancy and Wanda to consult about the website.
- Audrey Stewart reported on the work done by the task force to resolve the problem of what to do with the many years of scrap books. It was decided to dismantle the books and send the contents to the various creative groups and officers for final determination. The photos, however, would be retained for possible digitization and stored on the website.

The program was a PowerPoint presentation by Marion Kennedy of her 12-day trip to Hungary where she participated in numerous felting workshops.

The meeting was adjourned at 4:45 pm.
